WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Aqaba week actually runs.: A choreographed operation - berths, tenders and tables locked before wheels-down.
- Embark ready: APA open, crew briefed, transfer timed to Royal Yacht Club of Jordan.
- Local cadence: Morning toys, held lunch, short reposition around Aqaba, quiet overnight.
- Concierge lock: Restaurants and clubs confirmed weeks out - not left to chance.
- When to berth. When to anchor.: In Aqaba, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Harbour energy around Royal Yacht Club of Jordan, walk-ashore dinners, event visibility.
- At anchor: Swim platforms, quiet mornings, tender-only shore calls.
- The usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging in protected water.

Aqaba Reefs quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

Aqaba weather alternative

Captain-selected fallback when the primary plan densifies.

DAY ASHORE

Beach clubs

Secondary shore stop when the primary club densifies.

Aqaba Sunset Deck

Aqaba

End-of-day shore energy before returning aboard.

TRANSFERS

Airport to gangway.

We choreograph AQJ arrivals into Royal Yacht Club of Jordan.

Helicopter / GA

Private hops when Aqaba supports coastal helipads or GA strips into the Red Sea gateway. AQJ corridor

Chauffeur

SUV / S-Class briefed on Royal Yacht Club of Jordan gates - timed to embarkation. To Royal Yacht Club of Jordan 15-25 min from AQJ

Door-to-deck options are confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - AQABA

VAT & APA - Aqaba short version.

On a Aqaba charter the base fee is only the starting line. Budget tax treatment and a realistic APA before you lock dates.

VAT / tax

Jordan Aqaba special economic / charter rules - confirm berths, APA and Israel/Egypt day-call clearance separately. Confirm commercial charter tax treatment and APA with the broker before deposit.

APA

For Aqaba in high season, budget APA at roughly 30-40% of base fee covering fuel, berths, permits and held tables - confirm against LOA and itinerary.

What we send PAs

A line-item estimate before deposit, then a live APA report from the captain during the week.

Tala Bay is a core Aqaba charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Tala Bay Marina - Day-anchor: Aqaba overnight roadstead - Table: Tala Bay Shore Kitchen

BEFORE YOU FLY

FAQ

When is the best time for yacht charter in Aqaba?

Shoulder months in Red Sea usually balance weather and berth availability for Aqaba near Royal Yacht Club of Jordan.

Which marina should we embark from in Aqaba?

Royal Yacht Club of Jordan is the primary embarkation for Aqaba, with anchorage fallbacks when LOA or events block the preferred quay.

How far ahead should we book berths in Aqaba?

For peak season around Aqaba, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger yachts; shoulder season is more flexible. We open the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist.

What does APA usually cover on a Aqaba charter?

Fuel, berthing, food and beverage, and most guest concierge extras. For Aqaba we set an honest APA band before contract - not a vague percentage.

Can you arrange airport transfers into Aqaba?

Yes - chauffeur and helicopter where available from AQJ, timed to the embarkation slot at Royal Yacht Club of Jordan.

How does a Aqaba week use Royal Yacht Club?

Royal Yacht Club is a core Aqaba pocket - we sequence Royal Yacht Club of Jordan nights and day-anchors so the week feels unhurried. Aqaba sits inside Aqaba as a focused stop, not a duplicate of the country hub.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Aqaba - Royal Yacht Club of Jordan

High in peak season around Aqaba - broker relationships matter for larger LOA. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Event or festival weeks near Aqaba can multiply rates and eliminate availability. We hold Royal Yacht Club of Jordan alternatives and anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
