CASA DE CAMPO

Overview

Casa de Campo is a focused Dominican Republic charter stop - Casa de Campo Marina nights, day-anchors like Casa de Campo approaches, and shore tables held before you fly. The operational win is sequencing a short, high-quality loop rather than forcing the whole Dominican Republic circuit.

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter in Casa de Campo: Casa de Campo Marina, swim mornings and held tables. Enquire with Blue Ocean Club.

WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Casa de Campo week actually runs.: A choreographed operation - berths, tenders and tables locked before wheels-down.
- Embark ready: APA open, crew briefed, transfer timed to Casa de Campo Marina.
- Local cadence: Morning toys, held lunch, short reposition around Casa de Campo, quiet overnight.
- Concierge lock: Restaurants and clubs confirmed weeks out - not left to chance.
- When to berth. When to anchor.: In Casa de Campo, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Harbour energy around Casa de Campo Marina, walk-ashore dinners, event visibility.
- At anchor: Swim platforms, quiet mornings, tender-only shore calls.
- The usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging in protected water.

We choreograph PUJ / SDQ arrivals into Casa de Campo Marina.

Helicopter / GA

Private hops when Casa de Campo supports coastal helipads or GA strips into the Caribbean gateway. PUJ corridor SDQ corridor

Chauffeur

SUV / S-Class briefed on Casa de Campo Marina gates - timed to embarkation. To Casa de Campo Marina 45-60 min from PUJ

Door-to-deck options are confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - CASA DE CAMPO

VAT & APA - Casa de Campo short version.

On a Casa de Campo charter the base fee is only the starting line. Budget tax treatment and a realistic APA before you lock dates.

VAT / tax

Dominican Republic applies local ITBIS/VAT-style taxes; yacht temporary admission and charter licensing should be confirmed with a local agent.

APA

For Dominican Republic in high season, budget APA at roughly 30-40% of the base charter fee covering fuel, berths, food and concierge extras.

What we send PAs

A line-item estimate before deposit, then a live APA report from the captain during the week.

Casa de Campo

Casa de Campo is a core Dominican Republic charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Casa de Campo Marina - Day-anchor: Catalina Island - Table: La Cana by Il Circo

FAQ

When is the best time for yacht charter in Casa de Campo?

Shoulder months usually balance weather, water and berth availability for Casa de Campo. Peak midsummer adds density and premium quay pricing at Casa de Campo Marina.

Which marina should we embark from in Casa de Campo?

Casa de Campo Marina is the primary embarkation for Casa de Campo, with anchorage fallbacks when LOA or events block the preferred quay.

How far ahead should we book berths in Casa de Campo?

For peak season around Casa de Campo, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger yachts; shoulder season is more flexible. We open the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist.

What does APA usually cover on a Casa de Campo charter?

Fuel, berthing, food and beverage, and most guest concierge extras. For Casa de Campo we set an honest APA band before contract - not a vague percentage.

Can you arrange airport transfers into Casa de Campo?

Yes - chauffeur and helicopter where available from PUJ / SDQ, timed to the embarkation slot at Casa de Campo Marina.

How does a Casa de Campo week use La Romana & Catalina?

La Romana & Catalina is a core Casa de Campo pocket - we sequence Casa de Campo Marina nights and day-anchors so the week feels unhurried. Casa de Campo sits inside Dominican Republic as a focused stop, not a duplicate of the country hub.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Casa de Campo - Casa de Campo Marina

High in peak season around Casa de Campo - broker relationships matter for larger LOA. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. Event or festival weeks near Casa de Campo can multiply rates and eliminate availability. We hold Casa de Campo Marina alternatives and anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
