GREECE

Overview

Greece yacht charter spans Cyclades photogenic loops, Saronic short hops from Athens, and greener Ionian weeks out of Corfu. Embark at Alimos / Flisvos, Tourlos Mykonos or Gouvia - we hold meltemi-aware itineraries, peak berths and ATH/JMK/CFU door-to-deck before wheels-down.

Greece yacht charter - Mykonos Tourlos, Athens marinas, Santorini & Corfu. Berths, meltemi planning and APA with Blue Ocean Club.

WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Greece week actually runs.: Meltemi-aware legs, one Mykonos or Hydra quay night, and swim mornings in protected bays.
- Attica or island embark: Alimos / Flisvos or Tourlos - transfer timed, APA open.
- Island cadence: Paros / Naxos / Koufonisia or Saronic short hops - protect swim mornings.
- Tables locked: Nammos, Kiki's or Hydra tavernas held weeks out.
- Plan around the meltemi.: July-August northerlies shape Cyclades routing - captains build lee-shore options before deposit.
- North coasts: Skip when forecasts stack - we never invent calm.
- South / west bays: Default swim and overnight play in peak meltemi.
- Saronic / Ionian: Shorter hops when the Cyclades brief is wind-sensitive.

Cruising grounds

Cyclades

Mykonos-Paros-Naxos-Santorini arc - windy afternoons, iconic village nights.

Saronic Gulf

Hydra, Spetses and Poros - short hops from Athens.

Ionian Islands

Corfu to Kefalonia - greener, calmer water and long lunches.

Dodecanese

Rhodes-Symi-Kos corridor for east-Aegean charters.

Sporades

Skiathos and Skopelos pine coasts - family-friendly swim mornings.

QUAY NIGHTS

Marinas & berthing

Flisvos Marina

Athens Riviera megayacht base - primary embark for Cyclades and Saronic loops. - Max LOA ~140 m - Draft ~8 m - Gateway ATH - Transfer 25-40 min from ATH - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Tourlos Marina, Mykonos

Mykonos commercial yacht harbour - town and beach-club access. - Max LOA ~80 m - Draft ~5 m - Gateway JMK - Transfer 15-25 min from JMK - Peak lead: 8-16 weeks July-August

Gouvia Marina, Corfu

Ionian gateway - Corfu embark for Paxos, Lefkada and Kefalonia. - Max LOA ~80 m - Draft ~6 m - Gateway CFU - Transfer 15-25 min from CFU - Peak lead: 4-8 weeks peak

Athens Marina (Agios Kosmas)

Alternative Athens berth with Saronic day-trip reach. - Max LOA ~100 m - Draft ~7 m - Gateway ATH - Transfer 35-55 min from ATH - Peak lead: 4-10 weeks peak

Vlychada Marina, Santorini

South Santorini marina - caldera tender nights often preferred for larger LOA. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~3.5 m - Gateway JTR - Transfer 20-35 min from JTR - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Fiskardo harbour, Kefalonia

North Kefalonia yacht harbour - Ionian island-hopping base. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~3.5 m - Gateway EFL - Transfer 45-70 min from EFL - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

DAY WATER

Anchorage

Ornos Bay

Mykonos swim and club tender base when Tourlos is full.

Kolona, Kythnos

Double-bay thermal anchorage - classic Cyclades overnight.

Kini Bay, Syros

Quiet alternative to Ermoupoli quay nights.

Vathi, Meganisi

Ionian favourite - taverna dinghy and protected hook.

Paleokastritsa

Corfu west-coast day-stop in settled weather.

Harbour classic overlooking the fleet.

Beach clubs**Nammos**

Psarou

Mykonos scene club - tender booking essential in July-August.

Beach-club day with music and long lunch.

Principote

Panormos

Large Mykonos club for yacht parties.

DOOR TO DECK

Airport to Greek marina.

ATH, JMK, JTR and CFU into Alimos, Tourlos, Vlychada and Gouvia - chauffeur timed to embarkation.

ATH / JMK / CFU / JTR

Match the gateway to the first night - don't force a Mykonos arrival for an Athens embark. ATH Alimos / Flisvos 35-55 min
 JMK Tourlos 15-25 min CFU Gouvia 15-25 min

Chauffeur / speedboat

SUV to Attica marinas; island taxis briefed on Tourlos gates. Luggage aboard before guests when late Night-before hotel near ATH when needed

See embark utility for meeting points and berth lead times.

NUMBERS - GREECE

Greek VAT & APA - the short version.

Confirm reduced VAT on qualifying charter and budget APA for fuel, berths and beach-club tables.

VAT

Greece often cites ~12% on qualifying charter - confirm itinerary and flag structure.

APA

High-season Mykonos weeks push APA toward 35-40% once tables and fuel are real.

Fuel

Meltemi legs and generator nights belong in the APA line-item before deposit.

Mykonos

Mykonos is a core Greece charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Flisvos Marina - Day-anchor: Ornos Bay - Table: Hippie Fish

Santorini

Santorini is a core Greece charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Tourlos Marina, Mykonos - Day-anchor: Kolona, Kythnos - Table: Nobu Mykonos

Kefalonia

Kefalonia is a core Greece charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Gouvia Marina, Corfu - Day-anchor: Kini Bay, Syros - Table: Kodylenia's Taverna

Corfu

Corfu is a core Greece charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Athens Marina (Agios Kosmas) - Day-anchor: Vathi, Meganisi - Table: Taverna Vrahos

Child destinations

- Mykonos - Crewed yacht charter in Mykonos - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Greece.
- Santorini - Crewed yacht charter in Santorini - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Greece.
- Kefalonia - Crewed yacht charter in Kefalonia - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Greece.
- Corfu - Crewed yacht charter in Corfu - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Greece.

BEFORE YOU FLY

FAQ

Cyclades or Ionian for a first Greece week?

Cyclades for iconic islands and meltemi-aware planning; Ionian for greener, calmer family water out of Corfu / Lefkada.

Where do larger yachts berth in Mykonos?

Tourlos new port takes serious LOA when the old harbour is full - we hold Ornos / Psarou tender plans for beach-club days.

Is Santorini practical for overnight berthing?

Vlychada is the southern marina alternative to Athinios ferry chaos; many weeks day-stop the caldera and overnight elsewhere.

What APA should we budget in Greece?

Plan ~30-40% in high season - fuel against meltemi legs, Nammos-tier tables and peak berths move the needle.

Best airport for embarkation?

ATH for Attica / Saronic / Cyclades starts; JMK for Mykonos-centric weeks; CFU for Ionian; JTR when Santorini is the hinge.

Can we combine Greece with Turkey?

Yes on longer Aegean programmes - Dodecanese into Bodrum / Göcek when clearance and weather align.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Tourlos Marina, Mykonos

Peak July-August scarce for larger LOA. 8-16 weeks high season. Party weeks and August densify Tourlos and old-port approaches. Hold Ornos / Psarou tender plans; don't promise old harbour overnight for megayachts.

Athens Marina / Flisvos

Practical Attica embark - busier than island quays. 4-10 weeks peak. Athens events densify road transfers more than berths. Default Cyclades / Saronic start - ATH door-to-deck is the cleanest mainland play.

Gouvia Marina, Corfu

Easier than Cyclades peak - still book ahead July-August. 4-8 weeks peak. August family density; shoulder is flexible. Ionian embark hub - Paxos and Lefkada within short legs.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
