WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Sainte-Anne week actually runs.: A choreographed operation - berths, tenders and tables locked before wheels-down.
- Embark ready: APA open, crew briefed, transfer timed to Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access.
- Local cadence: Morning toys, held lunch, short reposition around Sainte-Anne, quiet overnight.
- Concierge lock: Restaurants and clubs confirmed weeks out - not left to chance.
- When to berth. When to anchor.: In Sainte-Anne, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Harbour energy around Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access, walk-ashore dinners, event visibility.
- At anchor: Swim platforms, quiet mornings, tender-only shore calls.
- The usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging in protected water.

Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access - primary Sainte-Anne yacht berthing. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway FDF - Transfer Day sail from Le Marin - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

DAY WATER

Anchorage

Sainte-Anne day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access.

Sainte-Anne overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access is full.

Sainte-Anne lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Martinique circuit.

Martinique overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Caribbean.

Le Marin lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Martinique circuit.

Sainte-Anne quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

Sainte-Anne

Secondary shore stop when the primary club densifies.

Martinique Sunset Deck

Fort-de-France

End-of-day shore energy before returning aboard.

TRANSFERS

Airport to gangway.

We choreograph FDF arrivals into Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access.

Helicopter / GA

Private hops when Sainte-Anne supports coastal helipads or GA strips into the Caribbean gateway. FDF corridor

Chauffeur

SUV / S-Class briefed on Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access gates - timed to embarkation. To Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access Day sail from Le Marin

Door-to-deck options are confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - SAINTE-ANNE

VAT & APA - Sainte-Anne short version.

On a Sainte-Anne charter the base fee is only the starting line. Budget tax treatment and a realistic APA before you lock dates.

VAT / tax

French Caribbean VAT/charter context - confirm with broker.

APA

APA 30-40% for fuel, Le Marin berths and held Creole tables.

What we send PAs

A line-item estimate before deposit, then a live APA report from the captain.

Fort-de-France

Fort-de-France is a core Martinique charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Fort-de-France yacht berths - Day-anchor: Fort-de-France day anchorage - Table: Fort-de-France Harbour Table

Le Marin

Le Marin is a core Martinique charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Marina du Marin - Day-anchor: Martinique overnight roadstead - Table: Le Marin Shore Kitchen

BEFORE YOU FLY

FAQ

When is the best time for yacht charter in Sainte-Anne?

Shoulder months in Caribbean usually balance weather and berth availability for Sainte-Anne near Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access.

Which marina should we embark from in Sainte-Anne?

Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access is the primary embarkation for Sainte-Anne, with anchorage fallbacks when LOA or events block the preferred quay.

How far ahead should we book berths in Sainte-Anne?

For peak season around Sainte-Anne, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger yachts; shoulder season is more flexible. We open the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist.

What does APA usually cover on a Sainte-Anne charter?

Fuel, berthing, food and beverage, and most guest concierge extras. For Sainte-Anne we set an honest APA band before contract - not a vague percentage.

Can you arrange airport transfers into Sainte-Anne?

Yes - chauffeur and helicopter where available from FDF, timed to the embarkation slot at Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access.

How does a Sainte-Anne week use South Caribbean coast?

South Caribbean coast is a core Sainte-Anne pocket - we sequence Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access nights and day-anchors so the week feels unhurried. Sainte-Anne sits inside Martinique as a focused stop, not a duplicate of the country hub.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Sainte-Anne - Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access

High in peak season around Sainte-Anne - broker relationships matter for larger LOA. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. Event or festival weeks near Sainte-Anne can multiply rates and eliminate availability. We hold Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access alternatives and anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
