SANTORINI

Overview

Think of Santorini as a precision week inside Greece: embark near Vlychada Marina, Santorini, protect swim mornings at Aspronisi lee, and book Ambrosia early. Blue Ocean Club brokers the berths and APA before contract.

Private yacht charter in Santorini via ATH / JMK. Charter a yacht for a week - berths, day-anchors and shore days by Blue Ocean Club.

WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Santorini week actually runs.: A choreographed operation - berths, tenders and tables locked before wheels-down.
- Embark ready: APA open, crew briefed, transfer timed to Vlychada Marina, Santorini.
- Local cadence: Morning toys, held lunch, short reposition around Santorini, quiet overnight.
- Concierge lock: Restaurants and clubs confirmed weeks out - not left to chance.
- When to berth. When to anchor.: In Santorini, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Harbour energy around Vlychada Marina, Santorini, walk-ashore dinners, event visibility.
- At anchor: Swim platforms, quiet mornings, tender-only shore calls.
- The usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging in protected water.

Cruising grounds

Cyclades

Mykonos-Paros-Naxos-Santorini arc - windy afternoons, iconic village nights.

Saronic Gulf

Hydra, Spetses and Poros - short hops from Athens.

QUAY NIGHTS

Marinas & berthing

Vlychada Marina, Santorini

South Santorini marina - caldera tender nights often preferred for larger LOA. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~3.5 m - Gateway JTR - Transfer 20-35 min from JTR - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

DAY WATER

Anchorage

Vlychada roadstead

Southern staging near the marina.

Aspronisi lee

Caldera swim stop in settled weather only.

Athiniós clear water

Hold clear of ferry lanes - captains pick lee pockets.

Ornos Bay

Mykonos swim and club tender base when Tourlos is full.

Kolona, Kythnos

Double-bay thermal anchorage - classic Cyclades overnight.

Caldera fine dining - chauffeur from Vlychada.

Sunset tasting menus above the caldera.

TRANSFERS

Airport to gangway.

We choreograph ATH / JMK arrivals into Vlychada Marina, Santorini.

Helicopter / GA

Private hops when Santorini supports coastal helipads or GA strips into the Mediterranean gateway. ATH corridor JMK corridor JTR corridor

Chauffeur

SUV / S-Class briefed on Vlychada Marina, Santorini gates - timed to embarkation. To Vlychada Marina, Santorini 20-35 min from JTR

Door-to-deck options are confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - SANTORINI

VAT & APA - Santorini short version.

On a Santorini charter the base fee is only the starting line. Budget tax treatment and a realistic APA before you lock dates.

VAT

Greece often cites ~12% on qualifying charter - confirm itinerary and flag structure.

APA

High-season Mykonos weeks push APA toward 35-40% once tables and fuel are real.

Fuel

Meltemi legs and generator nights belong in the APA line-item before deposit.

Santorini

Santorini is a core Greece charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Tourlos Marina, Mykonos - Day-anchor: Kolona, Kythnos - Table: Nobu Mykonos

BEFORE YOU FLY

FAQ

When is the best time for yacht charter in Santorini?

Shoulder months usually balance weather, water and berth availability for Santorini. Peak midsummer adds density and premium quay pricing at Vlychada Marina, Santorini.

Which marina should we embark from in Santorini?

Vlychada Marina, Santorini is the primary embarkation for Santorini, with anchorage fallbacks when LOA or events block the preferred quay.

How far ahead should we book berths in Santorini?

For peak season around Santorini, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger yachts; shoulder season is more flexible. We open the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist.

What does APA usually cover on a Santorini charter?

Fuel, berthing, food and beverage, and most guest concierge extras. For Santorini we set an honest APA band before contract - not a vague percentage.

Can you arrange airport transfers into Santorini?

Yes - chauffeur and helicopter where available from ATH / JMK, timed to the embarkation slot at Vlychada Marina, Santorini.

How does a Santorini week use Cyclades?

Cyclades is a core Santorini pocket - we sequence Vlychada Marina, Santorini nights and day-anchors so the week feels unhurried. Santorini sits inside Greece as a focused stop, not a duplicate of the country hub.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Santorini - Vlychada Marina, Santorini

High in peak season around Santorini - broker relationships matter for larger LOA. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Event or festival weeks near Santorini can multiply rates and eliminate availability. We hold Vlychada Marina, Santorini alternatives and anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
