Overview

A Turks & Caicos week succeeds on choreography: Turtle Cove Marina nights, Grace Bay reef day-anchors (including Turks & Caicos overnight roadstead), and APA set before deposit. Blue Ocean Club brokers the Caribbean reality - embark via PLS, not a brochure loop.

Crewed Turks & Caicos yacht charter - Grace Bay reef cruising, marina nights and yacht charter cost clarity. Live fleet with Blue Ocean Club.

WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Turks & Caicos week actually runs.: A choreographed operation - Turtle Cove Marina, tenders and tables locked before wheels-down.
- Embark ready: APA open, crew briefed, transfer timed to Turtle Cove Marina.
- Coastal cadence: Morning toys at Providenciales day anchorage, held lunch, short reposition through Grace Bay reef, quiet overnight.
- Concierge lock: Providenciales Harbour Table and Providenciales Beach Club confirmed weeks out.
- When to berth. When to anchor.: In Turks & Caicos, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Harbour energy at Turtle Cove Marina, walk-ashore dinners, event visibility.
- At anchor: Providenciales day anchorage - swim platforms, quiet mornings, tender-only shore calls.
- The usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging in protected water.

QUAY NIGHTS

Marinas & berthing

Turtle Cove Marina

Turtle Cove Marina - primary Providenciales yacht berthing. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway PLS - Transfer 15-25 min from PLS - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Grace Bay yacht / tender access

Grace Bay yacht / tender access - primary Grace Bay yacht berthing. - Max LOA ~35 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway PLS - Transfer 20-30 min from PLS - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

South Side Marina / Caicos Marina

South Side Marina / Caicos Marina - primary South Side Provo yacht berthing. - Max LOA ~45 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway PLS - Transfer 25-40 min from PLS - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

North Caicos yacht access

North Caicos yacht access - primary North Caicos yacht berthing. - Max LOA ~35 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway PLS - Transfer Day run from Provo - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Turks & Caicos Hub Berths

Pillar-retained secondary berthing capacity for Turks & Caicos ecosystem maps. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway PLS - Transfer 15-25 min from PLS - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

DAY WATER

Anchorage

Providenciales day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Turtle Cove Marina.

Turks & Caicos overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Caribbean.

Grace Bay lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Turks & Caicos circuit.

South Side Provo quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

Turks & Caicos weather alternative

Captain-selected fallback when the primary plan densifies.

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

Held table for yacht parties - advance booking in season.

DAY ASHORE

Beach clubs

Providenciales Beach Club

Signature shore stop near Turtle Cove Marina - tender access and advance booking in peak weeks.

Grace Bay Day Shore

Secondary shore lunch when the primary club is dense.

Turks & Caicos Sunset Deck

Providenciales

End-of-day shore energy before returning aboard.

TRANSFERS

Airport to gangway.

We choreograph PLS arrivals into Turtle Cove Marina transfers.

Helicopter / GA

Private hops from PLS when Turks & Caicos supports coastal helipads or GA strips. PLS corridor

Chauffeur

SUV / S-Class briefed on Turtle Cove Marina gates - timed to embarkation. To Turtle Cove Marina (15-25 min from PLS) To Grace Bay yacht / tender access (20-30 min from PLS)

Door-to-deck options are confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - TURKS & CAICOS

VAT & APA - Turks & Caicos short version.

On a Turks & Caicos charter the base fee is only the starting line. Budget tax treatment and a realistic APA before you lock dates.

VAT / tax

Turks & Caicos cruising permits and charter licensing required - confirm APA and park fees with broker. Confirm commercial charter tax treatment and APA with the broker before deposit.

APA

For Turks & Caicos in high season, budget APA at roughly 30-40% of base fee covering fuel, berths, permits and held tables - confirm against LOA and itinerary.

What we send PAs

A line-item estimate before deposit, then a live APA report from the captain during the week.

North Caicos

North Caicos is a core Turks & Caicos charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth

context: North Caicos yacht access - Day-anchor: South Side Provo quiet hook - Table: South Side Provo Waterfront

FAQ

What does it cost to charter a yacht in Turks & Caicos?

What it costs to charter a yacht in Turks & Caicos tracks yacht size and peak weeks. Smaller crewed sailing yachts and cats start lower; superyachts scale into six figures. APA, local tax context (Turks & Caicos cruising permits and charter licensing required - confirm APA and park fees with broker. Confirm commercial charter tax treatment and APA with the broker before deposit.) and berthing are confirmed in writing before deposit.

Which marina should we embark from in Turks & Caicos?

We match embarkation to LOA, flight into PLS, and the first night's plan - often Turtle Cove Marina when available.

Can you charter a superyacht in Turks & Caicos?

Megayacht and superyacht charter weeks in Turks & Caicos need earlier berth holds than midsize yachts. Blue Ocean Club sequences quay politics with the captain before contract.

How far ahead should we book berths in Turks & Caicos?

For peak season and event weeks around Turks & Caicos, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger yachts; shoulder season is more flexible. We open the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist.

What does APA usually cover on a Turks & Caicos charter?

Fuel, berthing, food and beverage, and most guest concierge extras. Tax context for Turks & Caicos: Turks & Caicos cruising permits and charter licensing required - confirm APA and park fees with broker. Confirm commercial charter tax treatment and APA with the broker before deposit. We set an indicative APA band before contract.

Can you arrange airport transfers into Turks & Caicos?

Yes - chauffeur and helicopter where available from PLS, timed to the embarkation slot at Turtle Cove Marina.

We hold Grace Bay yacht / tender access alternatives and Providenciales day anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

South Side Marina / Caicos Marina

High in peak season around Turks & Caicos - broker relationships matter for larger LOA at South Side Marina / Caicos Marina. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Event or festival weeks near Turks & Caicos can multiply rates and eliminate availability at South Side Marina / Caicos Marina. We hold South Side Marina / Caicos Marina alternatives and Providenciales day anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
