PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Vila do Abraão yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical GIG quay timing: Day sail from Angra. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Vila do Abraão yacht access

Door-to-deck for Ilha Grande: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Vila do Abraão yacht access - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Vila do Abraão yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

GIG

Typical GIG quay: Day sail from Angra. Typical transfer: Day sail from Angra

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Nearby dining

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Vila do Abraão yacht access - book peak weeks ahead.

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Vila do Abraão yacht access.

Walk-ashore dining near Porto Bracuhy - book peak weeks ahead.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Ilha Grande day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Vila do Abraão yacht access.

Ilha Grande overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Vila do Abraão yacht access is full.

Ilha Grande lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Brazil Costa Verde circuit.

Angra dos Reis day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Porto Bracuhy.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Ilha Grande high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Vila do Abraão yacht access?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your GIG arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Vila do Abraão yacht access?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Ilha Grande.

What does berthing cost at Vila do Abraão yacht access?

What berthing costs at Vila do Abraão yacht access depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Vila do Abraão yacht access?

Private yacht charter from Vila do Abraão yacht access is common for Ilha Grande weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Vila do Abraão yacht access?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Vila do Abraão yacht access?

Typical GIG quay timing: Day sail from Angra. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Ilha Grande day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Vila do Abraão yacht access?

Vila do Abraão yacht access typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
