PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical STT quay timing: 25-40 min from STT. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT STT

TYPICAL TRANSFER 25-40 min from STT

EMBARK UTILITY

American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

Door-to-deck for US Virgin Islands: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

STT

Typical STT quay: 25-40 min from STT. Typical transfer: 25-40 min from STT

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks US Virgin Islands high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**Why plan a American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook berth with Blue Ocean Club?**

Red Hook St Thomas berth - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

How do I embark at American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your STT arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for US Virgin Islands.

What does berthing cost at American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook?

Berthing at American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook?

Yes - American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in US Virgin Islands. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for American Yacht Harbor, Red Hook?

Typical STT quay timing: 25-40 min from STT. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Trunk Bay moorings is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
