Blue Ocean Club holds peak slips and APA before you fly.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Protected north-coast French marina near Grand Case.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 6-12 weeks peak. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical SXM quay timing: 30-45 min from SXM. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Anse Marcel Marina Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

Door-to-deck for St Martin / Sint Maarten: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Anse Marcel Marina - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 6-12 weeks peak. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Protected north-coast French marina near Grand Case.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

SXM

Typical SXM quay: 30-45 min from SXM. Typical transfer: 30-45 min from SXM

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Lolo's / Grand Case lolos

French-side grill culture - book against marina nights.

Tropismo / Marina restaurants

Lagoon-side convenience when services nights are held.

Le Pressoir, Grand Case

More formal French-side evening - hold early in peak.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Pinel Island

French-side day-stop with beach clubs.

Tintamarre

Nature islet day-hook.

Happy Bay

Hike-in north-coast beach.

Anguilla Road Bay

Customs day-trip anchorage.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks St Martin / Sint Maarten high season and local events - 6-12 weeks peak lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

Why plan a Anse Marcel Marina berth with Blue Ocean Club?

St Martin north quiet berth - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

How do I embark at Anse Marcel Marina?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your SXM arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Anse Marcel Marina?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 6-12 weeks peak Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for St Martin / Sint Maarten.

What does berthing cost at Anse Marcel Marina?

What berthing costs at Anse Marcel Marina depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Anse Marcel Marina?

Private yacht charter from Anse Marcel Marina is common for St Martin / Sint Maarten weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Anse Marcel Marina?

6-12 weeks peak

What is the practical embarkation airport for Anse Marcel Marina?

Typical SXM quay timing: 30-45 min from SXM. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Pinel Island is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
