PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Paradise Island basin - captains coordinate with harbour; NAS chauffeur with bridge buffer.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 6-12 weeks winter; longer for holidays. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical NAS quay timing: 20-40 min from NAS. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

Door-to-deck for Nassau: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 6-12 weeks winter; longer for holidays. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Paradise Island basin - captains coordinate with harbour; NAS chauffeur with bridge buffer.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

NAS

Typical NAS quay: 20-40 min from NAS. Typical transfer: 20-40 min from NAS

Peak density tracks Nassau high season and local events - 6-12 weeks winter; longer for holidays lead time is typical for larger LOA.

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

Why plan a Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island berth with Blue Ocean Club?

Nassau Paradise Island berth - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

How do I embark at Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your NAS arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 6-12 weeks winter; longer for holidays Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Nassau.

What does berthing cost at Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island?

Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Nassau week.

Is yacht charter available from Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island?

6-12 weeks winter; longer for holidays

What is the practical embarkation airport for Atlantis Harbour / Paradise Island?

Typical NAS quay timing: 20-40 min from NAS. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Warderick Wells is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
