PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Bahia Mar Yachting Center with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Confirm fuel, shore power amp rating and waste before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths around Bahia Mar Yachting Center typically need 4-12 weeks for larger LOA. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Primary gateway MIA. We choreograph chauffeur or helicopter into the gangway window.

AIRPORT MIA

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Bahia Mar Yachting Center

Door-to-deck for Fort Lauderdale: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Bahia Mar Yachting Center - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths around Bahia Mar Yachting Center typically need 4-12 weeks for larger LOA. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Bahia Mar Yachting Center with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Confirm fuel, shore power amp rating and waste before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

MIA

Primary gateway MIA.

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Berth and size figures are indicative. Berthing is heavily restricted around the Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show in late October and early November.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Bahia Mar Yachting Center?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your MIA arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Bahia Mar Yachting Center?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. For peak season and event weeks, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger LOA; shoulder season is more flexible. Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Fort Lauderdale.

What does berthing cost at Bahia Mar Yachting Center?

Berthing at Bahia Mar Yachting Center is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Bahia Mar Yachting Center?

Yes - Bahia Mar Yachting Center is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Fort Lauderdale. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Bahia Mar Yachting Center?

For peak season and event weeks, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger LOA; shoulder season is more flexible. We start the berth conversation when the yacht shortlist is open.

What is the practical embarkation airport for Bahia Mar Yachting Center?

Primary gateway MIA. We choreograph chauffeur or helicopter into the gangway window.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Lake Sylvia is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Bahia Mar Yachting Center?

We confirm fuel, shore power, water and waste against your LOA with the marina agent before contract.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
