## Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

## TRANSFERS

## Door to deck

---

Typical GST quay timing: Park vessel / Juneau staging. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

## EMBARK UTILITY

## Embark at Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay

---





Door-to-deck for Glacier Bay: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

| <b>MEETING POINT</b>  | Meeting point: Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.                             |
| <b>ARRIVAL BUFFER</b> | Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed. |
| <b>PEAK LEAD TIME</b> | Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.                                    |

### **Captain notes**

Park entry permits and vessel rules apply - plan ahead.

### **Tender fallback**

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

### **Luggage / hotel**

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

### **GST**

Typical GST quay: Park vessel / Juneau staging. Typical transfer: Park vessel / Juneau staging

# Nearby dining

### **Onboard galley focus**

Park weeks are yacht-led - shore plates in Juneau/Gustavus ends.

### **Gustavus Inn**

Gateway dinner before/after park entry.

### **Glacier Bay Lodge dining**

Park-edge plates at Bartlett Cove.

### **The Rookery Café**

Juneau casual.

# Nearby anchorages

### **Bartlett Cove**

Park entry overnight - permits required.

### **North / South Marble Island approaches**

Wildlife day - distance rules.

### **Johns Hopkins Inlet staging**

Tidewater glacier day - ice aware.

### TIMING

## Seasonal note

---

Peak density tracks Glacier Bay high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

## Berth fees

---

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

### BEFORE YOU FLY

## Berthing FAQ

---

### How do I embark at Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your GST arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

### Can I berth a yacht at Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Glacier Bay.

### What does berthing cost at Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay?

Berthing at Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

### Is yacht charter available from Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay?

Yes - Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Glacier Bay. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

### How far ahead should we book a berth at Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

### What is the practical embarkation airport for Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay?

Typical GST quay timing: Park vessel / Juneau staging. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

### Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Bartlett Cove is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

### What services should we expect at Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay?

Bartlett Cove, Glacier Bay typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.
