## PILOTAGE NOTES

## Approach

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Approach D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead.

## HOLDS &amp; LEAD TIMES

## Berthing

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Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

## TRANSFERS

## Door to deck

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Typical BJV quay timing: Coastal transfer from BJV. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

## EMBARK UTILITY

## Embark at D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths

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Door-to-deck for Turkey: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

#### MEETING POINT

Meeting point: D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.

#### ARRIVAL BUFFER

Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.

#### PEAK LEAD TIME

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

#### Captain notes

Approach D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead.

#### Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

#### Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

#### BJV

## Seasonal note

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Peak density tracks Turkey high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

### INDICATIVE DRAFT

## Berth fees

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Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

### BEFORE YOU FLY

## Berthing FAQ

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### How do I embark at D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your BJV arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

### Can I berth a yacht at D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Turkey.

### What does berthing cost at D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths?

What berthing costs at D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

### Is yacht charter available from D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths?

Private yacht charter from D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths is common for Turkey weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

### How far ahead should we book a berth at D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

### What is the practical embarkation airport for D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths?

Typical BJV quay timing: Coastal transfer from BJV. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

### Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Cleopatra Bay is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

### What services should we expect at D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths?

D-Marin Didim / Kuadas corridor berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.
