## HOLDS &amp; LEAD TIMES

## Berthing

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Peak berths typically need 6-14 weeks peak. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

## Door to deck

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Typical FLL quay timing: 15-25 min from FLL. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

## EMBARK UTILITY

## Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

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Door-to-deck for Fort Lauderdale: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

| <b>MEETING POINT</b>  | Meeting point: Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.           |
| <b>ARRIVAL BUFFER</b> | Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed. |
| <b>PEAK LEAD TIME</b> | Peak berths typically need 6-14 weeks peak. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.                                                     |

### **Captain notes**

Fort Lauderdale Yacht Capital cluster - FLL corridor.

### **Tender fallback**

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

### **Luggage / hotel**

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

### **FLL**

Typical FLL quay: 15-25 min from FLL. Typical transfer: 15-25 min from FLL

## TIMING

**Seasonal note**

Peak density tracks Fort Lauderdale high season and local events - 6-14 weeks peak lead time is typical for larger LOA.

**Berth fees**

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

## BEFORE YOU FLY

**Berthing FAQ****Why plan a Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex berth with Blue Ocean Club?**

Fort Lauderdale berth - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

**How do I embark at Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your FLL arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

**Can I berth a yacht at Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex?**

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 6-14 weeks peak Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Fort Lauderdale.

**What does berthing cost at Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex?**

Berthing at Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

**Is yacht charter available from Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex?**

Yes - Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Fort Lauderdale. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

**How far ahead should we book a berth at Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex?**

6-14 weeks peak

**What is the practical embarkation airport for Palm Harbor Marina / Fort Lauderdale complex?**

Typical FLL quay timing: 15-25 min from FLL. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

**Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?**

Lake Sylvia is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

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*Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.*
