PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Harbour Village Marina with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical BON quay timing: 15-25 min from BON. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Harbour Village Marina

Door-to-deck for Bonaire: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Harbour Village Marina - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Harbour Village Marina with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

BON

Typical BON quay: 15-25 min from BON. Typical transfer: 15-25 min from BON

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Bonaire Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Harbour Village Marina - book peak weeks ahead.

Bonaire Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day around Bonaire in the ABC Islands circuit.

Harbour Village Marina Quay Dining

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Harbour Village Marina.

Aruba Harbour Table

Walk-ashore dining near Renaissance / Oranjestad yacht berths - book peak weeks ahead.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Bonaire day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Harbour Village Marina.

Bonaire overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Harbour Village Marina is full.

Bonaire lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the ABC Islands circuit.

Aruba day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Renaissance / Oranjestad yacht berths.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Bonaire high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Harbour Village Marina?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your BON arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Harbour Village Marina?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Bonaire.

What does berthing cost at Harbour Village Marina?

What berthing costs at Harbour Village Marina depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Harbour Village Marina?

Private yacht charter from Harbour Village Marina is common for Bonaire weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Harbour Village Marina?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Harbour Village Marina?

Typical BON quay timing: 15-25 min from BON. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Bonaire day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Harbour Village Marina?

Harbour Village Marina typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
