PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical EIS quay timing: Ferry or yacht from Tortola. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

Door-to-deck for Virgin Gorda: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

EIS

Typical EIS quay: Ferry or yacht from Tortola. Typical transfer: Ferry or yacht from Tortola

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Virgin Gorda high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

Why plan a Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda berth with Blue Ocean Club?

Virgin Gorda north sound - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

How do I embark at Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your EIS arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Virgin Gorda.

What does berthing cost at Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda?

What berthing costs at Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda?

Private yacht charter from Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda is common for Virgin Gorda weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Yacht Harbour / Leverick Creek area, Virgin Gorda?

Typical EIS quay timing: Ferry or yacht from Tortola. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

The Bight, Norman Island is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
