PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical NOS quay timing: 20-40 min from NOS. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

20-40 min from NOS

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths

Door-to-deck for Madagascar Nosy Be: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

NOS

Typical NOS quay: 20-40 min from NOS. Typical transfer: 20-40 min from NOS

Nosy Be Harbour Table

Walk-ashore dining near Hell-Ville / Nosy Be yacht berths - book peak weeks ahead.

Nosy Komba Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day on the water around Madagascar Nosy Be.

Madagascar Nosy Be Quay Classic

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

Nosy Iranja Waterfront

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Nosy Be day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Hell-Ville / Nosy Be yacht berths.

Madagascar Nosy Be overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Indian Ocean.

Nosy Komba lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Madagascar Nosy Be circuit.

Nosy Iranja quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Madagascar Nosy Be high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your NOS arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Madagascar Nosy Be.

What does berthing cost at Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths?

What berthing costs at Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths?

Private yacht charter from Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths is common for Madagascar Nosy Be weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths?

Typical NOS quay timing: 20-40 min from NOS. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Nosy Be day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths?

Madagascar Nosy Be Hub Berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
