## PILOTAGE NOTES

## Approach

---

Approach Puerto Deportivo de Marbella with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

## HOLDS &amp; LEAD TIMES

## Berthing

---

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

## TRANSFERS

## Door to deck

---

Typical AGP quay timing: 40-55 min from AGP. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

## EMBARK UTILITY

## Embark at Puerto Deportivo de Marbella

---

Door-to-deck for Marbella: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

| <b>MEETING POINT</b>  | Meeting point: Puerto Deportivo de Marbella - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.                           |
| <b>ARRIVAL BUFFER</b> | Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed. |
| <b>PEAK LEAD TIME</b> | Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.                                    |

### Captain notes

Approach Puerto Deportivo de Marbella with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

### Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

### Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

### AGP

Typical AGP quay: 40-55 min from AGP. Typical transfer: 40-55 min from AGP

## TIMING

**Seasonal note**

Peak density tracks Marbella high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

## INDICATIVE DRAFT

**Berth fees**

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

## BEFORE YOU FLY

**Berthing FAQ****How do I embark at Puerto Deportivo de Marbella?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your AGP arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

**Can I berth a yacht at Puerto Deportivo de Marbella?**

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Marbella.

**What does berthing cost at Puerto Deportivo de Marbella?**

Berthing at Puerto Deportivo de Marbella is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

**Is yacht charter available from Puerto Deportivo de Marbella?**

Yes - Puerto Deportivo de Marbella is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Marbella. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

**How far ahead should we book a berth at Puerto Deportivo de Marbella?**

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

**What is the practical embarkation airport for Puerto Deportivo de Marbella?**

Typical AGP quay timing: 40-55 min from AGP. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

**Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?**

Marbella roadstead is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.





### What services should we expect at Puerto Deportivo de Marbella?

Puerto Deportivo de Marbella typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

*Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.*
