Marina di Portisco - Quieter Smeralda alternative with strong services. Marina di Portisco yacht berth guide for crewed yacht charter in Costa Smeralda - mooring notes, OLB door-to-deck timing, nearby day-anchors and tables like Grill Restaurant below. Blue Ocean Club holds peak slips and APA before you fly.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Quieter Smeralda services marina - strong embark alternative to Porto Cervo.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 6-12 weeks peak. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical OLB quay timing: 30-45 min from OLB. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Marina di Portisco Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

Door-to-deck for Costa Smeralda: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Marina di Portisco - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 6-12 weeks peak. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Quieter Smeralda services marina - strong embark alternative to Porto Cervo.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

OLB

Typical OLB quay: 30-45 min from OLB. Typical transfer: 30-45 min from OLB

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Costa Smeralda high season and local events - 6-12 weeks peak lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**Why plan a Marina di Portisco berth with Blue Ocean Club?**

Quiet Smeralda services - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

How do I embark at Marina di Portisco?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your OLB arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Marina di Portisco?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 6-12 weeks peak Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Costa Smeralda.

What does berthing cost at Marina di Portisco?

Marina di Portisco berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Costa Smeralda week.

Is yacht charter available from Marina di Portisco?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Marina di Portisco as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Marina di Portisco?

6-12 weeks peak

What is the practical embarkation airport for Marina di Portisco?

Typical OLB quay timing: 30-45 min from OLB. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Cala di Volpe is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
