Overview

Marina di Porto Cervo sits in the natural inlet behind Porto Cervo, the purpose-built heart of the Costa Smeralda on Sardinia's north-east coast. Yachts come for a rare combination: sheltered harbour water, polished superyacht services, a social calendar led by Yacht Club Costa Smeralda, and cruising grounds that unfold almost immediately beyond the breakwater. Within a short run lie the Maddalena Archipelago, Caprera, Spargi, Cala di Volpe and the granite-fringed beaches that made this coast famous. Ashore, Porto Cervo is compact but intensely curated, with whitewashed arcades, designer boutiques, waterside restaurants and late-night terraces arranged around a village that was shaped in the 1960s under Prince Karim Aga Khan IV. For charter guests, the marina works as both arrival stage and operating base: a place to board in style, dine well within minutes of stepping off the passerelle, and reposition quickly between beach days, regattas, island anchorages and Sardinian interiors.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Marina di Porto Cervo with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Confirm fuel, shore power amp rating and waste before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths around Marina di Porto Cervo typically need 4-12 weeks for larger LOA. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Primary gateway OLB. We choreograph chauffeur or helicopter into the gangway window.

AIRPORT

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Marina di Porto Cervo

Door-to-deck for Sardinia: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT

Meeting point: Marina di Porto Cervo - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.

ARRIVAL BUFFER

Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.

PEAK LEAD TIME

Peak berths around Marina di Porto Cervo typically need 4-12 weeks for larger LOA. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Marina di Porto Cervo with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Confirm fuel, shore power amp rating and waste before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

OLB

Primary gateway OLB.

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Quattro Passi al Pescatore

A polished Porto Cervo waterfront address for refined seafood, marina views and a classic Costa Smeralda evening. Book well ahead in July, August and regatta weeks.

You Marina

Set close to the marina, You Marina suits guests wanting cocktails, contemporary plates and a smooth transition from dinner into late drinks.

Novikov Porto Cervo

A seasonal branch of the international Novikov name, useful for groups seeking a familiar high-energy dining style in a smart resort setting.

Nuna al Sole

A relaxed option in Porto Cervo for pasta, seafood and unfussy evenings when guests prefer village atmosphere over full theatre.

Frades La Terrazza

Located at Promenade du Port, Frades focuses on Sardinian produce with a modern presentation and is a good choice for a more local sense of place.

Il Pomodoro

A long-standing Porto Cervo favourite for families, casual pasta, pizza and grilled dishes, especially useful for earlier dinners with children.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Golfo del Pevero

A convenient fair-weather anchorage close to Porto Cervo, with clear water and quick access to Grande and Piccolo Pevero.

Cala di Volpe

Yachts gather here for sheltered water, famous hotel views, beach-club access and classic Costa Smeralda swimming.

Liscia Ruja

A broad sandy bay with turquoise shallows, popular for relaxed beach days and water toys in settled conditions.

Cala Portese, Caprera

A scenic Caprera anchorage with granite surroundings and clear water, subject to Maddalena National Park regulations.

Porto Palma, Caprera

A well-known Caprera stop for transparent water, island scenery and a quieter feel when conditions and rules allow.

Cala Corsara, Spargi

A spectacular Spargi anchorage of pale sand and sculpted rocks, best visited with careful attention to park restrictions.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Porto Cervo's peak season runs from late June through August, with the highest pressure on berths, restaurants, drivers and provisioning during July, August and major regatta periods. September remains important because sailing events such as the Maxi Yacht Rolex Cup draw a serious yachting crowd, often with better temperatures and a more nautical tone than high-summer party weeks. The principal weather consideration is the mistral, which can arrive strongly from the north-west and change anchorage choices quickly across the Costa Smeralda and Maddalena channels. Local sea breezes are common in summer afternoons, while mornings are often calmer for passages and guest transfers. Book marina space and headline restaurants months ahead for peak dates, and reconfirm all arrival times. May, early June, late September and early October offer strong shoulder-season advantages: clearer anchorages, softer light, easier tables and warm enough water in many years, though some seasonal venues may open late or close early.

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Marina di Porto Cervo?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your OLB arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Marina di Porto Cervo?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. For peak season and event weeks, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger LOA; shoulder season is more flexible. Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Sardinia.

What does berthing cost at Marina di Porto Cervo?

Berthing at Marina di Porto Cervo is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Marina di Porto Cervo?

Yes - Marina di Porto Cervo is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Sardinia. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Marina di Porto Cervo?

For peak season and event weeks, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger LOA; shoulder season is more flexible. We start the berth conversation when the yacht shortlist is open.

What is the practical embarkation airport for Marina di Porto Cervo?

Primary gateway OLB. We choreograph chauffeur or helicopter into the gangway window.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Golfo del Pevero is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Marina di Porto Cervo?

We confirm fuel, shore power, water and waste against your LOA with the marina agent before contract.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
