PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Cruise-ship traffic in peak season; book town quay early.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical TIV quay timing: 20-35 min from TIV. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT	TIV
TYPICAL TRANSFER	20-35 min from TIV

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Port of Kotor

Door-to-deck for Kotor: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Port of Kotor - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Cruise-ship traffic in peak season; book town quay early.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

TIV

Typical TIV quay: 20-35 min from TIV. Typical transfer: 20-35 min from TIV

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Kotor high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Port of Kotor?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your TIV arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Port of Kotor?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Kotor.

What does berthing cost at Port of Kotor?

Port of Kotor berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Kotor week.

Is yacht charter available from Port of Kotor?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Port of Kotor as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Port of Kotor?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Port of Kotor?

Typical TIV quay timing: 20-35 min from TIV. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Kotor bay holding is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Port of Kotor?

Port of Kotor typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
