PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Port of Roses with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical GRO quay timing: 45-65 min from GRO. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT	GRO
TYPICAL TRANSFER	45-65 min from GRO

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Port of Roses

Door-to-deck for Roses: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Port of Roses - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Port of Roses with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

GRO

Typical GRO quay: 45-65 min from GRO. Typical transfer: 45-65 min from GRO

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Roses high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Port of Roses?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your GRO arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Port of Roses?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Roses.

What does berthing cost at Port of Roses?

Berthing at Port of Roses is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Port of Roses?

Yes - Port of Roses is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Roses. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Port of Roses?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Port of Roses?

Typical GRO quay timing: 45-65 min from GRO. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Aigua Blava / Fornells is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Port of Roses?

Port of Roses typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
