## PILOTAGE NOTES

## Approach

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Approach Port de Porto-Vecchio with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

## HOLDS &amp; LEAD TIMES

## Berthing

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Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

## TRANSFERS

## Door to deck

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Typical AJA quay timing: 30-40 min from AJA. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

## EMBARK UTILITY

## Embark at Port de Porto-Vecchio

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Door-to-deck for Porto-Vecchio: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

| <b>MEETING POINT</b>  | Meeting point: Port de Porto-Vecchio - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.                                  |
| <b>ARRIVAL BUFFER</b> | Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed. |
| <b>PEAK LEAD TIME</b> | Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.                                    |

### Captain notes

Approach Port de Porto-Vecchio with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

### Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

### Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

### AJA

Typical AJA quay: 30-40 min from AJA. Typical transfer: 30-40 min from AJA

## TIMING

**Seasonal note**

Peak density tracks Porto-Vecchio high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

## INDICATIVE DRAFT

**Berth fees**

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

## BEFORE YOU FLY

**Berthing FAQ****How do I embark at Port de Porto-Vecchio?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your AJA arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

**Can I berth a yacht at Port de Porto-Vecchio?**

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Porto-Vecchio.

**What does berthing cost at Port de Porto-Vecchio?**

Port de Porto-Vecchio berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Porto-Vecchio week.

**Is yacht charter available from Port de Porto-Vecchio?**

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Port de Porto-Vecchio as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

**How far ahead should we book a berth at Port de Porto-Vecchio?**

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

**What is the practical embarkation airport for Port de Porto-Vecchio?**

Typical AJA quay timing: 30-40 min from AJA. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

**Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?**

Santa Giulia is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.





### What services should we expect at Port de Porto-Vecchio?

Port de Porto-Vecchio typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

*Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.*
