PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical SDQ quay timing: Yacht or transfer via SDQ/AZS. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná

Door-to-deck for Samaná: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

SDQ

Typical SDQ quay: Yacht or transfer via SDQ/AZS. Typical transfer: Yacht or transfer via SDQ/AZS

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Samaná high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your SDQ arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Samaná.

What does berthing cost at Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná?

Berthing at Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná?

Yes - Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Samaná. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná?

Typical SDQ quay timing: Yacht or transfer via SDQ/AZS. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Cayo Levantado is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná?

Puerto Bahía Marina, Samaná typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
