PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical SOU quay timing: 40-70 min from SOU. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

40-70 min from SOU

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths

Door-to-deck for Solent & Isle of Wight: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

SOU

Typical SOU quay: 40-70 min from SOU. Typical transfer: 40-70 min from SOU

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

Portsmouth Waterfront

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Cowes day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Cowes Yacht Haven.

Solent & Isle of Wight overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Europe.

Lymington lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Solent & Isle of Wight circuit.

Portsmouth quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Solent & Isle of Wight high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your SOU arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Solent & Isle of Wight.

What does berthing cost at Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths?

What berthing costs at Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths?

Private yacht charter from Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths is common for Solent & Isle of Wight weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths?

Typical SOU quay timing: 40-70 min from SOU. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Cowes day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths?

Solent & Isle of Wight Hub Berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
