PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical ARN quay timing: 35-55 min from ARN. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT ARN

TYPICAL TRANSFER 35-55 min from ARN

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths

Door-to-deck for Stockholm Archipelago: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

ARN

Typical ARN quay: 35-55 min from ARN. Typical transfer: 35-55 min from ARN

Nearby dining

Stockholm Harbour Table

Walk-ashore dining near Wasahamnen / Stockholm yacht berths - book peak weeks ahead.

Sandhamn Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day on the water around Stockholm Archipelago.

Stockholm Archipelago Quay Classic

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

Vaxholm Waterfront

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Stockholm day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Wasahamnen / Stockholm yacht berths.

Stockholm Archipelago overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Europe.

Sandhamn lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Stockholm Archipelago circuit.

Vaxholm quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Stockholm Archipelago high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your ARN arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Stockholm Archipelago.

What does berthing cost at Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths?

What berthing costs at Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths?

Private yacht charter from Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths is common for Stockholm Archipelago weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths?

Typical ARN quay timing: 35-55 min from ARN. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Stockholm day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths?

Stockholm Archipelago Hub Berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
