Village Cay Marina, Tortola - Road Town harbour marina - classic BVI embark. Village Cay Marina, Tortola yacht berth guide for crewed yacht charter in Tortola - mooring notes, EIS door-to-deck timing, nearby day-anchors and tables like Pusher's / Sidney's Peace & Love below. Blue Ocean Club holds peak slips and APA before you fly.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Road Town basin - captains coordinate with marina; EIS corridor for embark day.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 6-12 weeks winter; longer for New Year. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical EIS quay timing: 15-25 min from EIS. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Village Cay Marina, Tortola Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

Door-to-deck for Tortola: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Village Cay Marina, Tortola - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 6-12 weeks winter; longer for New Year. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Road Town basin - captains coordinate with marina; EIS corridor for embark day.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

EIS

Typical EIS quay: 15-25 min from EIS. Typical transfer: 15-25 min from EIS

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Tortola high season and local events - 6-12 weeks winter; longer for New Year lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**Why plan a Village Cay Marina, Tortola berth with Blue Ocean Club?**

Road Town embark - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

How do I embark at Village Cay Marina, Tortola?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your EIS arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Village Cay Marina, Tortola?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 6-12 weeks winter; longer for New Year Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Tortola.

What does berthing cost at Village Cay Marina, Tortola?

What berthing costs at Village Cay Marina, Tortola depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Village Cay Marina, Tortola?

Private yacht charter from Village Cay Marina, Tortola is common for Tortola weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Village Cay Marina, Tortola?

6-12 weeks winter; longer for New Year

What is the practical embarkation airport for Village Cay Marina, Tortola?

Typical EIS quay timing: 15-25 min from EIS. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

The Bight, Norman Island is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
